What is Cloud-IO?

Cloud-IO is our hybrid cloud service designed specially to meet the numerous and varied challenges that organisations face today. It's comprised of:

- A dedicated, enterprise-grade storage platform hosted in one of our secure datacentres in your organisation's home country
- A network comprised of direct, high-speed, low-latency connections into public cloud providers such as Amazon Web Services (AWS) and Microsoft Azure
- Full ITIL-based Service Management and support with an easy-to-understand Service Level Agreement.

You get to keep your data in private storage within your organisation's home country – and access it from anywhere, quickly, via low-latency links in the public cloud.

You'll know exactly where your data is at all times – and still be able to enjoy benefits such as scalability, agility and efficiency.

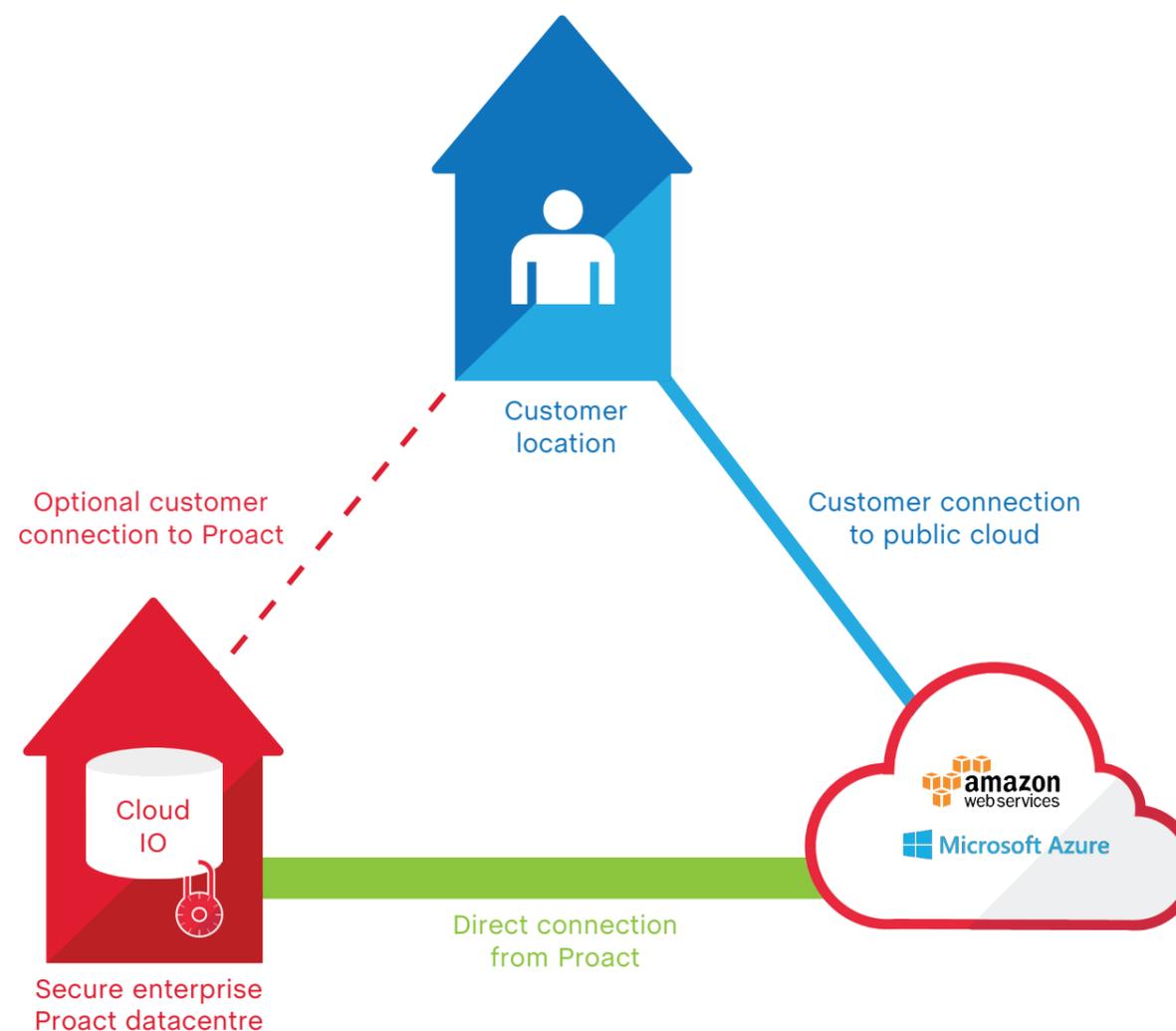
Cloud-IO also means you are free to move between public cloud providers without having to worry about complex and costly data migration.
